Bishop Ignatius Mascarenhas, Sr. Teresa Attupuram, the provincial superior, Fr. Rajesh, the vice Provincial of IMS, Fr. Paul Raj, Sr. Deepti, Sr. Savio and Srishti one of the first students of Sacred Heart school. Sr. Teresa Attupuram, Provincial Superior of Delhi province of SCJMs, in her introduction said that the life of the sisters in that mission area was very demanding as people were totally unfamiliar with the Christian way of life.



The melodious music and singing enabled everyone to experience peace and serenity during the Holy Eucharist.
